**Italian Reds**

Ancora Montepulciano D'Abruzzo 2008 9.50 38.00

Montepulciano is the grape, Abruzzo is the region. A deep vibrant spicy red with warm hearty fruit.

Villa Vistarenni Chianti Classico 2007 10.50 42.00

A full-bodied red wine suitable to accompany red meats, roasts and game.

Frescobaldi Nipozzano 2007 65.00  
Reserva Chianti Rufina

It appears a deep, purple-edged ruby red, of impressive brilliance. Solid fruit notes of wild blackberry, blueberry, raspberry and dark cherry emerge initially on the nose, gradually yielding to more pungent impressions of sage, rosemary, vanilla, and cinnamon.

Sassoregale Sangiovese Toscana 2007 10.00 40.00

Its colour is a bright ruby red. On the nose, it is clean and precise, with hints of morello cherries, wild berries and a moderate spiciness. On the palate it reveals a full-bodied, assertive flavour, which expresses both great intensity and elegance.

Montalto Syrah di Sicilia 2009 46.00

From Western Sicily, a balanced wine with spicy blackberry fruit

Barbera Di Asti Piemonte 2008 10.50 42.00

Vividly coloured, plum-skins sweet-sour, fruit packed with enlivening acidity, a low tannin level and a bone-fry finish

Frescobaldi Tenuta Di Catiglionni 2008 14.50 58.00

The wine appears a dense, almost opaque purple-red, but of striking luminosity. Intense, rich draughts of red berry fruit lead off on the nose, with raspberry and wild strawberry well in evidence, followed closely by rich blackberry and dark cherry. This impressive, multi-layered bouquet closes with spicier impressions of cocoa powder, tobacco leaf, vanilla and cinnamon. The palate is equally impressive for its warmth, velvet smoothness and complex balance, where dense but supple tannins are already well integrated into the structure. A tasty, nervy acidity fuels a lengthy progression, and it concludes with lovely fruit in a final crescendo.

**Shiraz/Syrah**

Carchello Monastrell Syrah 2009 9.00 36.00  
Jumilla, Spain

Massive spice and fruit bomb with lots of peppery black fruit, bell peppers, earthy minerals and full-bodied tannin, characteristics that, although being very youthful and present, are not obtrusive.

Wirra Wirra Scrubby Rise Shiraz 2009 10.00 40.00  
McLaren Vale, Australia

Dark chocolate & berry fruit spices. Enjoy with friends, a plate of food & lively conversation.

Man O War Dreadnought Syrah 2009 82.00  
Waiheke Island, NZ

Dreadnought opens up to aromas of white pepper, star anise and blueberries with hints of wild game and a subtle floral fragrance. The palate has a mineral vibrancy which holds the firm ripe tannins in check. It has layers of complex characters that unfold as the wine opens up in the glass revealing subtle hints of spice and game, and a rich supple palate.

Grant Burge Filsell Shiraz 2009 72.00  
Barossa Valley, Australia

This rich, full-bodied red wine shows excellent integration of oak and persistence of flavour.

5 Oaks 2010 36.00  
Nelson, NZ

Spicy red cherries with a light hint of savoury oak on the finish.

Barren Rock 2009 10.00 40.00  
Central Otago, NZ

Deep dark cherry and soft plum aromas are fully evident. This wine has superb depth of flavour, loads of ripe red fruits and hints of spiced oak on the finish.

Main Divide 2008 12.50 50.00  
Waipara, NZ

The wine has a bright, ruby hue with aromas and flavours of bright red fruits, including raspberries, blackberries, mulberries and cherries. There are also hints of grilled mushrooms and roast game, which give it an underlying savoury element.

Alexander Dusty Road 2008 45.00  
Martinborough, NZ

From one of Martinborough's smallest boutique vineyards. A lighter Pinot with a spicy sweet raspberry and red cherry fruits on both the nose and palate. The wine has a warm savouriness that is so good with Italian food.

Carrick 2009 80.00  
Central Otago, NZ

This wine exhibits subdued aromas of red cherry and briar. On the palate it is rich, dense and concentrated, with hints of spice and liquorice.

Thorn Clarke Sandpiper Merlot 2008 Barossa Valley, Australia	10.00	40.00
<i>Deep red in colour. The nose has clean ripe blackcurrant fruit with nuances of liquorice, mint and chocolate oak characters. The palate is medium bodied with an abundance of rich, sweet fruit.</i>		
Mebus Estate Merlot Cabernet 2008 Wairarapa, NZ		36.00
<i>Estate grown fruit from one of the warmest vineyard sites in the region. A delicious medium bodied three-way blend with savoury fruit flavours and soft tannins on the finish.</i>		
Chapoutier Cotes-du-Rhone Belleruche 2009 South Rhone, France	12.00	48.00
<i>Garnet red in colour. Aromas of red fruit &amp; morello cherries with flavours of spice, liquorice &amp; grey pepper. This wine has great structure with firm &amp; silky tannins.</i>		
Shingleback Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 McLaren Vale, Australia		52.00
<i>Deep magenta red. Lifted blackberry and cassis aromas with hints of truffle, violets and spice. Blackberry and dark chocolate flavours dominate the mid palate. A long blueberry fruit finish is defined with firm tannins and roasted cashew French oak. A full bodied varietal cabernet sauvignon, with the richness of fruit to satisfy now, and the structure that will reward the patient with the complexity that careful cellaring brings.</i>		
Te Mata Estate Awatea 2009 Cabernet Merlot, Hawkes Bay, NZ		66.00
<i>Awatea '09 has a deep magenta colour with aromas and flavours of ripe blackberry, wild strawberry and black plum with notes of vanilla, dark chocolate and thyme. The palate is rich with very fine-grained tannins supporting the ripe fruit flavours right through to the long finish.</i>		
Pegasus Bay Merlot Cabernet 2006 Waipara, NZ	15.00	60.00
<i>Merlot provides a purple plum fruit character, a plump fleshy structure and a backbone of ripe tannins. Malbec supports this and adds an aromatic rose-petal-like element. Cassis and blackcurrant impressions come from the cabernet sauvignon, while cabernet franc gives an ethereal fruitiness.</i>
